The decorative glass doors allow you to sense the contents within, but at the same time ensure a tidy appearance,” say Mathias Mentze and Alexander Ottenstein on their latest design for MENU. Opening to reveal bronzed brass fittings and two oak veneer shelves that can be placed at varying heights, the Curiosity Cabinet offers ample room to store your favourite objects – from everyday dinnerware and office essentials to home textiles and even clothes.
