MENU elevates the Passage Collection with a new Bar/ Counter chair design.

When Krøyer-Sætter-Lassen first imagined the Passage Collection in 2019, they wanted to create functional furniture pieces that generated feelings of creation and connection. The flat-pack design series for self-assembly furthers the feeling with the addition of the Passage Bar/ Counter Stool – an elevated version of their earlier seat design.

A natural addition to spaces we connect in – over a glass of wine, a meaningful conversation or big ideas – Passage Bar/Counter Stool is useful in a wide range of settings. Crafted in FSC-certified solid oak using traditional Danish cabinetmaking techniques, the clever flat-pack construction both reduces its footprint while allowing its owner to actively engage in the crafting process. A foot ring ensures a comfortable sitting position for prolonged periods and its bar height aligns perfectly with countertops. The ideal blend of function and comfort, Passage Bar/Counter Stool is available with a natural or dark lacquered finish to complement the existing designs in the collection.

About the Designer

The Copenhagen-based design studio Krøyer-Sætter-Lassen creates furniture and interior objects for clients across the world. Founded in 2016 by Mads Sætter-Lassen and Emil Krøyer, their honest approach to design results in logical, functional and sculptural objects that showcase their strong cultural understanding and Danish design heritage to bridge the gap between art and design.

Krøyer-Sætter Lassen began their collaboration at the Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts, School of Design, where they have graduated with their BA and subsequently, an MA. Their collaboration has grown from a give-and-take about art and design into the creation of existing projects. The duo recognizes their differences and strengths allowing them to approach their process from different character angles. Krøyer-Sætter Lassen engages each other to seek new materials and perspectives in order to work in a nicety way.

Krøyer and Sætter-Lassen's honest focus is revealed through their consideration of material properties and tectonic details. They prefer to make the conscious choice of turning a joint or assembly into a visible design asset instead of concealing it -keeping true to the industrial way.


