PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

The Vipp Cabin square table is a part of the Vipp Cabin series, a collection of complementary furniture crafted from natural solid oak. This table is characterised by its oblong shape and softly rounded edges. The base is composed of two solid pieces of carved oak with subtle joins, clearly demonstrating the pervasive detailing of the table.

Materials

Solid oak with a light or dark lacquered surface or a natural oiled surface.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

We recommend caring for your Vipp Cabin square table to preserve its natural appearance for many years to come. Oak is an organic material and should be treated with care. Follow the care instructions to prevent devitalisation from everyday wear and tear.

General care

Wipe down the table with a damp, soft cloth added a mild, PH-neutral detergent. Avoid using sponges or similar coarse cloths for cleaning as this might leave scratches. Do not use acidic cleaning agents as this will damage the surface and leave permanent stains. Make sure to remove spilled liquids immediately or it will leave stains. In case of permanent stains, please contact a professional for further instructions.

Grease and stains

Carefully remove stains with a cloth and a solution of water and PH-neutral soap flakes. Do not use sandpaper or similar as this might damage the protective layer of the surface.

Cleaning with soap flakes:

- Use ½ deciliter of soap flakes for a liter of hot water. Whip the soap flakes into the water.
- When the water reaches room temperature, apply the foam with a soft cloth.
Only use the foam, not the water, and avoid soaking the wood.
- When the tabletop is dry, polish with a soft, dry cotton cloth.

Oiled oak

For oiled oak surfaces a thorough maintenance is necessary. Use oil treatment 2-3 times a year or when needed. Follow the care instructions for oiled surfaces below.

- Follow the instructions of the oil treatment carefully and make sure to clean the surface before getting started. After treatment, make sure to destroy the oil cloth by rinsing it in cold water or storing it in an airtight metal or glass container as oil cloths may self-ignite if stored incorrectly.
- Carefully sand with sandpaper in case of scratches. Do not use steel wool. Use grain 240 sandpaper or a soft sponge added a little oil. Always grind over a larger area to avoid a recess on the spot. When working with abrasive materials it is important to work along the veins of the wood, not across. Wipe off the oil immediately with a dry cloth.

NOTE

We recommend saturating the table with a solution of water and dissolved, PH-neutral soap flakes (every 4-6 months to preserve its long-lasting appeal). Always use coasters for drinking glass and rivets for hot items to protect the wooden surface. Patina will develop over time.

Vipp offers warranty on products according to national laws and regulations. The warranty does not cover defects or damage caused directly or indirectly by misuse or poor maintenance, violence, or manipulation.

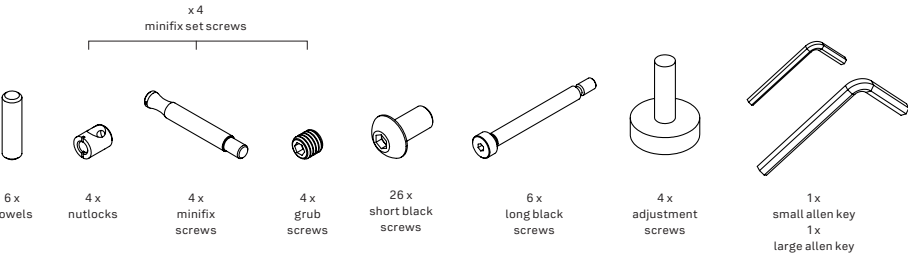
When unpacking your table, make sure to place all parts on a soft underlay to prevent scratches and to protect the floor. Handling of the table requires min. 4 people.

Assembling of legs

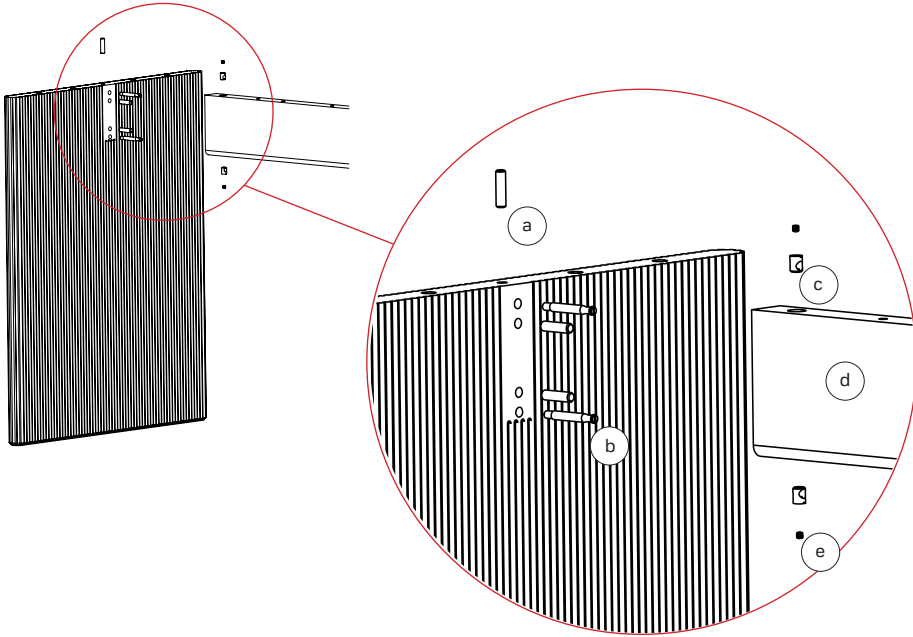
- Place 3 x dowels in each table leg (a).
- Place 2 x minifix screws in each table leg (b) next to the dowels (a). Tighten the minifix screws (b) with a screwdriver.
- Put the 4 x nutlocks (c) inside the outer holes of the support bar (d).
- Fasten the support bar (d) to the table legs by tightening the 2 x grub screws (e) to the minifix screws (b) with a screwdriver. Repeat on the other table leg.
- Mount the steel bracket (f) to each leg with 4 x short black screws (g). Use the large allen key.

Assembling of tabletop

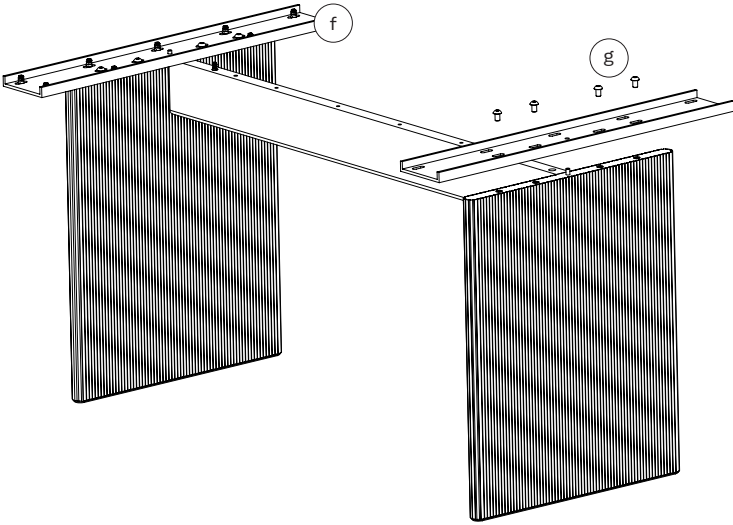
- Place the tabletop (h) on a soft underlay, with the bottom facing upwards.
- Mount the leg construction (i) on top of the tabletop (h) by fastening the support bar (d) with the 6 x long black screws (j). Use the small allen key.
- Fasten the steel bracket with the 9 x short black screws (g). Use the large allen key. Repeat on the other table leg.
- Use the height adjustment screws (k) to adjust the height of the table.
- Carefully flip the table on its feet (this requires min. 4 people).



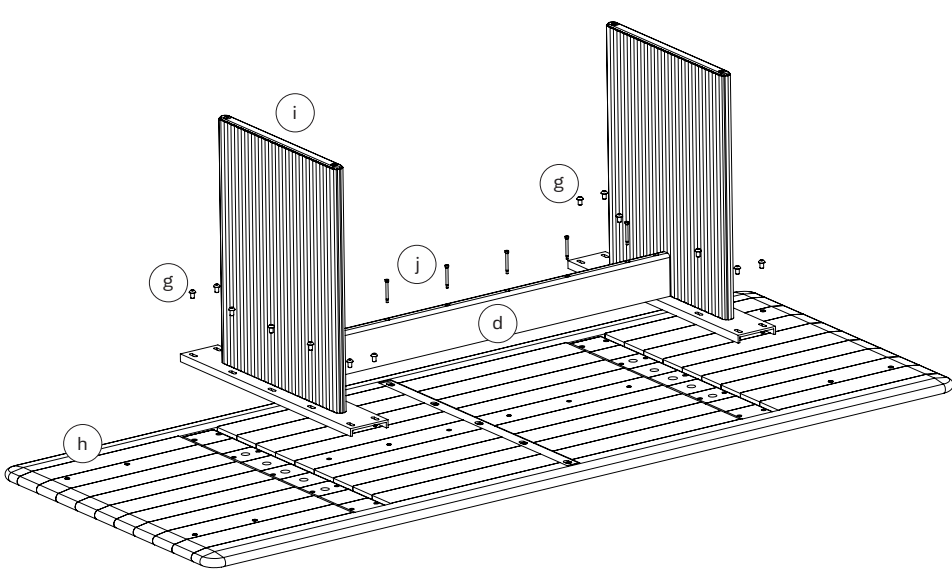
Assembling of legs 1-4
